



Do I Qualify for DACA? Possibly, If:

- Under age 31 as of June 15, 2012
- Entered U.S. prior to age 16
- At least 15 years old at time of request
- Have continuously resided in the U.S. since June 15, 2007, up to present time;
- Have not committed a felony or significant misdemeanor **Multiple misdemeanors are an automatic bar to DACA**
- Earned high school diploma or GED, or currently enrolled, or were honorably discharged from the U.S. Armed Forces

****Only an attorney or accredited representative can help you know for sure if you have a crime that may disqualify you from DACA.***

- Due to a recent announcement by the Trump administration, USCIS (the agency that administers DACA) is currently not accepting new DACA applications, BUT, you should still talk to an attorney or accredited representative if you believe you qualify.
