	manure/straw from EATM animals. We plan to rotate sets of (4) cans between EATM and site.
	We currently have 3 round trash cans that the manure/straw is placed. It fills every 2 days. Once the cans are filled
	the overflow manure goes into a regular dumpster for the landfill. Because the filled cans are heavy, a bucket tractor
	is used to bring them down to the compost site. This has proved difficult to coordinate on a regular basis resulting in
	minimal diversion from the landfill and loss of needed green waste for composting. Wheeled cans would allow the
	student interns to load them onto a trailer to be towed to the site at the same time the dumpster totes are towed to the
	trash compactor next to the Compost Project site.

The Compost Project is an ongoing student powered program. Operating costs for small items like gloves, plywood sheets, wire mesh, etc have been covered by the Biology department and the Maintenance department. We currently do not have funds for the wheeled trash cans.

8. Explain the benefits of this proposal to the student population (how many students will be affected) and how does the proposal meet the Co-curricular guidelines.

The Compost Project brings together students from various disciplines to learn about composting and to help the campus divert usable waste from

the landfill. Biology, Environmental Science, Engineering and Business student interns generate compost and work on projects specific to their majors.

Projects have included studies about compost composition, nutrient levels and microbial communities. A temperature data logger was designed and built.

The Compost Project has a crew of 24 interns each semester. In addition to the compost and major specific projects, the senior and lead interns learn crew management, site management and project management skills. The Compost Project has been a collaboration between Sciences, M&O, EATM and although staff and faculty advisors guide the students, the Compost Project is very much a student sustained program that benefits the entire campus community.

I understand that the allocated funds are for the proposed project only. Funds may not be carried over until next semester. All funds not expended will be retained in or returned to the Co-curricular Committee account. It is understood that the decisions of the Co-curricular Committee are final.
