

# PROGRAM OF STUDY

## Associate in Arts in Economics for Transfer Degree AA-T

The Associate in Arts in Economics for Transfer (AA-T in Economics) is intended for students who plan to transfer and complete a bachelor's degree in Economics, or similar major at a CSU campus. Students completing this degree are guaranteed admission to the CSU system, but not necessarily to a particular CSU campus or major of their choice. Students should consult with a counselor for more information on university admission and transfer requirements as this AA-T in Economics may not be the best option for students intending to transfer to a particular CSU campus or to a college or university that is not part of the CSU system.

To earn an AA-T in Economics, students must:

1. Complete 60 semester or 90 quarter CSU transferable units.
2. Obtain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in all CSU-transferable coursework. While a minimum of 2.0 is required for admission, some majors may require a higher GPA.
3. Complete 19-25 specified major units. All courses in the major must be completed with a grade of C or better or a "P" if the course is taken on a "pass-no-pass" basis (Title 5 § 55063). Even though a "pass-no-pass" is allowed, it is recommended that students complete their major courses with letter grade.
4. Obtain certification of the California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC for CSU) pattern.
