The Academic Senate is calling for nominations for faculty co-chairs for our standing committees:

- Curriculum Committee
- Distance Education Committee (DE)
- Education Committee on Accreditation and Planning (EdCAP)
- Facilities and Technology Committee on Accreditation and Planning (FTCAP)
- Professional Development Committee (PD)
- Student Learning Outcomes Committee (SLO)
- Student Success and Equity Committee (SEA)

Noon on Friday October 30 is the deadline for nominations and candidate statements to be submitted to me, ereese@vcccd.edu. Faculty may self-nominate or be nominated by their faculty peers and both part-time and full-time faculty may stand for these co-chair positions. The vote for these positions takes place during Academic Senate Council, currently scheduled for the November 17 meeting.

The call for faculty co-chair goes out every two years for election in the Fall semester so that the elected co-chairs have the opportunity to shadow the current co-chairs during the Spring semester. The two-year term for these positions starts June 1, 2021.
