1. Call to Order, Public Comments	Ruth Bennington asked everyone to share with their departments that the names of elected committee representatives should be sent to Academic Senate.		
Approval of March 9, 2021 Minutes	John Loprieno motioned to approve, and Ruth Bennington seconded. Corrected document title to "Moorpark SLO Committee Minutes". Minutes were approved with Trevor Hess abstaining.		

2. SLO Coordinator Report	Rachel Beetz attended two tech review meetings and updated CLOs for PHTC, RADT, PHOT, MUS, MATH, PSY, ANTH, and BUS.
	In eLumen, Rachel cleaned up duplicate courses, created and edited the assessment library, planned out assessments to faculty, and figured out how to update degrees and certificates. If any errors are found, please email Rachel.
	She drafted some possible survey questions, but they are still up for discussion. It would be best to send out the survey in the beginning of fall along with links to SLO resources. If recommended by the proper committee, Oleg Bespalov will explore adding a program plan topic or survey regarding which class modality has been more productive.
	Upcoming tasks include meetings or trainings on request, attend tech review meetings, update degrees and certificates, attend Student Services Learning Outcomes meetings, and First Friday session at 11:30 on May 7 th .
eLumen Update – Rachel and Oleg, Spring 2021 SLO Input into eLumen	Rachel pushed out assessments to everyone, but faculty will still have to update the SLO eLumen Data Collection Plan for spring. Oleg will send out an email that includes the collection plan spreadsheet that is due April 23 rd .
	The assessments deadline is May 21st and Rachel can assist faculty until May 16 th when her contract ends.
4. Continuing discussion on Student Services Outcomes - Oleg	Oleg, Rachel, Dani Vieira, and Ruth will meet with student service leads to review SLOs. A Student Services Outcomes spreadsheet will track SLOs and assessment methods because student services cannot easily be stored in eLumen. Hopefully, student services can begin assessing by the fall semester. ACCJC has a list of information that must be included in the college catalog. SLOs for Programs and Degrees are on the list and MC includes student
	services within this requirement.
5. Continue discussion of issues departments are facing with SLO entry and participation	Some feel there is still reluctance from faculty, especially adjunct, to enter SLO assessments. An email asking department chairs or division deans to explain the requirement of assessing SLOs every semester may help with the transition.
