



ASMC MANAGING CRISIS SCHOLARSHIP 2021

The Associated Students of Moorpark College (ASMC) Board of Directors awards the *Managing Crisis Scholarship* to Moorpark College students who enrich student life at Moorpark College with their commitment to excellence in academics, leadership, and campus involvement, but were adversely affected by the Coronavirus crisis.

A total of ten (10) MC students will be awarded a scholarship of \$1,500 each.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Moorpark College (MC) students are encouraged to apply for this scholarship if they:

- Have completed at least 12 units at MC over the course of the last two semesters;
- Have earned a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.2 or higher at MC;
- Are currently enrolled in a minimum of 12 units at MC for Spring 2021; and
- Are involved with student organizations, academic or student service units, or through academics;

HOW TO APPLY:

In addition to completing the *Managing Crisis Scholarship* applicant information sheet (next page), interested students are also asked to include the following required documents:

- **A one-page personal statement.** The document should describe the following: 1) your campus involvement outside of the classroom, such as student leadership in student organizations or other campus activities, which have enriched your educational experience at Moorpark College; 2) How will the scholarship make college more affordable to you? Explain how these activities may assist in your future endeavors. Font size and line spacing is up to the discretion of the applicant, though we ask that the essay be no more than one page in length.
- **A copy of your resume.** Your resume should include: any participation in student leadership, student organizations and/or campus involvement while attending Moorpark College; any achievements or special distinctions you have earned while attending Moorpark College; and any professional experience you think is relevant. This document should be no more than two pages in length.
- **One letter of recommendation.** We ask that the letter be from a Moorpark College staff or faculty member from someone whose statement can support your personal statement.
- **One copy of your current, unofficial transcript.** Unofficial transcripts are available to students through the Moorpark College Admissions & Records Office: MRecords@vcccd.edu.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The ASMC Scholarship Committee seeks to conduct a blind review of applications. Therefore, **please do not include your name on your application's supplemental materials.** Use your student ID number on your personal statement, resume, and letter of recommendation instead. Applicants who fail to include any of the aforementioned documents will be disqualified for consideration.
