Early childhood teacher, equity expert, and author, Nadia Jaboneta will share her riveting experiences partnering with families to explore cultural identity, religious celebrations and expressions of racism in her diverse preschool class. Join us to 1) understand the critical thinking and collaborative process that goes into social justice education, 2) explore how children learn about identity and appreciate difference, and 3) learn the strength that comes from courageous and vulnerable teaching.

Nadia Jaboneta lives in the San Francisco Bay area with her husband and 3 children. She is a program coordinator and classroom teacher at Pacific Primary preschool in San Francisco, California. She has 22 years experience in Early Childhood Education teaching young children, training teachers, consulting and facilitating workshops. She is passionate about social justice and is proud to have immigrant parents from Lima, Peru. It is because of their hard work, resilience and support that she is who she is today. Nadia attended San Francisco State University for both her Bachelor's and Master's degree. There she had the opportunity to learn about teacher research and the importance of capturing children's voices and to reflect on her own practice. She has written numerous articles for the magazine *Teaching Young Children*, focused on the anti-bias education practices she uses in her classroom. She also is the author of two popular books, one entitled *You Can't Celebrate That; Navigating the deep waters of social justice education*, and *Children's Lively Minds; Schema theory made visible*.
