Purpose

The specific tasks of this committee are:

- Review and evaluate campus-wide student success and equity data related to distance education
- Develop and promote best practices that contribute to the quality and growth of distance education at Moorpark College
- Provide guidance on professional development activities related to distance education
- Monitor and document compliance with accreditation standards and state and national regulations

Committee Goals – Adopted 10/27/2021

1. Modify and/or support online learning policies which address student equity. (PRT C1)
2. Assess instructional technology (Proctorio, Labster, Cranium Café, etc.) to determine usefulness for Moorpark College.
3. Assess impact of camera, microphone, and regular and effective contact policies, and recommend improvements as the findings warrant. (PRT C1a, C1c & C1d)
4. Review and modify Regular and Effective Contact Policy based on Federal and State best practices. (PRT C1b)
