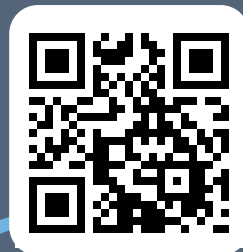
Open to all currently enrolled VCCCD students!

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Please submit an electronic copy of the design sized at least 3000 x 1800 pixels to both Tamarra Coleman and Dina Pielat (tcolemanhill@vcccd.edu and gpielat@vcccd.edu). Design should include FONT treatment for “Critical Conversations, Multicultural Day 2022”

The file should be submitted as a JPEG, PNG, PDF, AI, or PSD that is 3000 pixels wide by 1800 pixels tall. **A working file is preferable.** Feel free to also include a square version for social media. **Due Date: December 1, 2021**

The following text must be included in the design. “Critical Conversations” as well as “Moorpark College Multicultural Day”, “April 12, 2022”, and “www.moorparkcollege.edu/mcd”.

The annual festival features lectures, exhibits, learning activities, presentations, panel discussions, performances, storytelling, music, dance, theatre, demonstrations, hands-on activities and a variety of food, merchant, informational and educational booths ranging from local to international organizations.
