





The following guidelines will help you determine the Mathematics course in which you are most prepared:

Math M05 (College Algebra) Math M06 (Trigonometry) Math M07 (Pre-Calculus) Math M10 (Mathematics for Elementary Teachers) Math M15 (Introduction to Statistics)

If you have successfully completed High School Algebra II, you may freely enroll in any of our first level transferable courses

If you have not successfully completed High School Algebra II, please consider below the courses you are recommended to enroll in, based on your previous high school experience:

If your goal is to complete Math M05, Math M06 or Math M07:

- 1) Your High School GPA was at least 2.9: You are recommended to enroll in Math M03
- 2) Your High School GPA was below 2.9: You are recommended to enroll in Math M01
- 3) If you still wish to enroll in one of these three courses, regardless of the above recommendations, you to enroll in Math M05 + Math M905-S (College Algebra with Support)

If your goal is to complete Math M10: You may directly enroll.

If your goal is to complete Math M15:

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1) You have successfully completed High School Algebra I AND your High School GPA was at least 3.0:
