As a comprehensive program, EOPS is driven by a philosophy of providing services that are "over, above and in addition to" services to students.

If you are planning to transfer for Spring 2021, we hope that you have successfully submitted your applications by now. Make sure to periodically check and respond to your email to provide any missing information the universities may request, and also to create your student portal. Now will also be a good time to learn more about campuses before making your final decision. As well as submitting your updated information for UC/CSU application from your Fall semester and now Spring classes by **January 31st**. You should expect to receive decisions from each campus during late spring and should submit your intent to register by the deadline, which vary for each campus. You will also need to submit your final transcripts by May-July, attend a new student orientation during summer and start your Fall semester at the new campus. We wish you continuous success in your future educational endeavors.
