2021-2022 Funding Distributions | Programming Committee Associated Students of Moorpark College (ASMC)

The Associated Students of Moorpark College (ASMC) continued to promote campus life by sponsoring several events, activities, programs, and services throughout the year. Numerous purchase orders were established with local businesses to assist in ASMC's daily operations, as well as to help clubs and organizations host their meetings, campus-wide events, or attend conferences and trainings throughout the nation. ASMC was able to provide this support while remaining within its projected budgets and maintaining financial stability and positive balances in all its accounts. In total, the **ASMC Programming Committee distributed almost \$46,000 to sixteen (16) different campus organizations or departments in 2021-2022**.
