Workgroup reporting to Facilities CAP

Workgroup Charge:

The Planning Advisory Work Group (PAWG) is charged to look at secondary effects and space allocations. PAWG will deal with issues that PAWG already designated as space allocation issues and make recommendation on prioritization.

Membership:

- Faculty/Staff representative from each Student Learning Division
- Administrator representative
- Director of Facilities, Maintenance and Operations
- Designate Administrator and one Faculty representative as co-chairs of workgroup

Term of Office:

- Workgroup Committee members serve on a volunteer basis for one academic year

Responsibilities:

- Research each request for additional information based upon the prioritization criteria listed below.
 - Focus on Students
 - Welcoming and Accessible Campus
 - Collaborative Campus Environment
 - Progressive Learning Space
 - Sustainable Solution
 - Efficient and Cost Effective
 - Strengthen college/community connections
 - Impact on disproportionately impacted groups

Approximate Timeline:

- September
 - PAWG Volunteers Selected
 - List generated by Research Analyst to be submitted to PAWG
- November
 - PAWG carries out responsibilities of researching, categorizing, and ranking requests
- 1ST FCAP meeting in Spring
 - Recommendations submitted by PAWG to Facilities CAP Committee
 - Prioritization voting of requests completed by Facilities CAP Committee
