Since the fall of 2020, Moorpark uses eLumen to gather assessment data.

## For all Faculty:

Because of the interconnectedness of CLOs, faculty are expected to complete their assessments for every CLO, for every course, every semester.

## How to input scores:

1. Login
2. Select your scorecard icon for a particular course
3. Select a 1, 0, or n/a for each CLO for each student
4. Click "Save and continue to reflection"
5. Compose 2-3 sentences reflecting on overall student performance from this course. It should be anything that either you or other faculty might find helpful in preparing the course in the future based on student performance from this semester.
6. Select either "Submit and Share" or "Submit and Share Anonymously" according to your personal preference.
