I usually have classes on Tuesday and Thursday that run into the afternoon, which then I can take advantage of tutoring. I usually have tutoring for an hour for both my English essay and my Math until the room close. Unfortunately, I usually have more questions for Math when leaving the Zoom meeting, therefore to allocate some time maybe extend the session period in Zoom meetings. Really though the service was perfect and aside from that I see that there would never be any suggestions.

Send emails to anyone enrolled in accounting courses when accounting tutoring is (or will be) available. People/students are stressed, they may not be looking or know where to find resources. Or, just include it as part of the registration appointment email. For example, in the registration appointment email, you can include a reminder of when/where tutoring is available for the various disciplines. For example, if accounting tutors are available every Tuesday from 2-8pm via zoom for that semester, include that information as part of the registration reminder. The email that the president sends every term can also be used for this. In the president's office email, links for various sources can be listed at the end, or a list of links can be attached to the presidents email. If there is a flyer that is sent to everyone, like a school newspaper, it can also be included in that email.
