## **Student Privacy Rights**

Moorpark College adheres to the guidelines established by the <u>Family</u> <u>Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)</u>

(http://www2.ed.gov/policy/gen/guid/fpco/ferpa/index.html) - a federal legislation established to regulate access and maintenance of student records.

FERPA affords students certain rights with respect to their education records, including the right to:

- Inspect their education records
- Request an amendment of the records that the student believes are inaccurate
- Control disclosures of personally identifiable information contained in the students' education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.
- File a complaint with the <u>U.S. Department of Education</u> (<a href="https://studentprivacy.ed.gov/file-a-complaint">https://studentprivacy.ed.gov/file-a-complaint</a>) concerning alleged failures by the college to comply with the requirements of FERPA.

Parents, spouses and significant others have no inherent right to access student educational records.
