Based on a projected enrollment of 19,000 headcount and associated WSCH, Art generates a need for nearly 3 times as much space to not only accommodate growth, but correct existing deficiencies. Music/Dance (which includes music theory, composition, instrumental, vocal and keyboard performance; and dance appreciation, history, and performance) are nearing or exceeding capacity in their existing facilities. Dance has been forced, due to space constraints, to offer course in the student center cafeteria and off-campus; while Music continually competes with Performing Arts for rehearsal and performance space. Based on a projected enrollment of 19,000 headcount and associated WSCH, Dance generates a need for 1 additional studio, and Music nearly double the amount of existing space to not only accommodate growth, but correct existing deficiencies.
