Footnotes:

(1) Projected delinquencies for this report are based on Student Data Warehouse’s default prevention software program logic that takes existing delinquencies and extrapolates that to expected future delinquencies counts. This is a statistical projection and is subject to change based on actual counts.

(2) The cohort default rate projection is calculated based on the current default rate plus projected delinquencies and assumes 30%, 40%, or 50% of the delinquencies will be cured by any party from the date of the report through the end of the cohort. In the event the college has no default prevention outreach in place, the projected cure rates used in this report could be higher than expected and for the college that has outreach efforts in place lower than expected.
