## Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) for STEM Pattern

- 1. IGETC for STEM may only be used with the following ADTs: Biology, Chemistry and Environmental Science.
- 2. Students obtaining an ADT using the IGETC without the completion of the Oral Communication (Area 1C) will not meet the CSU admissions requirements.
- 3. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester or 4 quarter units and must be completed with a "C" or better, or Pass/Credit. A "C" is defined as a minimum 2.0 grade points on a 4.0 scale. The UC system allows a maximum of 14 semester units graded "Pass/No-Pass".
- 4. Full IGETC for STEM must include: All courses in Areas 1, Area 2A, Area 5, and Area 7; and one course in Area 3A, one course in Area 3B; and one course in Area 4 (the 2<sup>nd</sup> Area 4 course will need to be from a different academic discipline); one course in Area 6 for UC-bound students who have not satisfied it through proficiency. *NOTE:* The deferred lower division courses must be replaced with calculus and/or science courses required by the major before transfer.
- 5. UC will accept IGETC for STEM if the UC school/college/major program to which the student transfers accepts partial IGETC certification. For more information, consult with a counselor.
