

Synopsis

Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street is the unsettling tale of a Victorian-era barber who returns home to London after fifteen years of exile to take revenge on the corrupt judge who ruined his life. When revenge eludes him, Sweeney swears vengeance on the entire human race, murdering as many people as he can, while his business associate Mrs. Lovett bakes the bodies into meat pies and sells them to the unsuspecting public. Perhaps composer/lyricist Stephen Sondheim's most perfect score, *Sweeney Todd* is lush, operatic, and full of soaring beauty, pitch-black comedy and stunning terror.

Director's Mote:

"There's a hole in the world like a great black pit and the vermin of the world inhabit it and its morals aren't worth what a pig could spit...!"



In this quote from the play, we see the world through the eyes of the titular character, Sweeney Todd. Through the lens of a man consumed with revenge, we see the world as a great black pit inhabited by vermin. How fitting that the theme of revenge is interwoven with the cannibalism as Sweeney ultimately consumes himself in his hate-fueled pursuit.

Sondhiem has given us this wondrous score that is at once beautiful and horrific; just as he has also peopled this darkest of musicals with many unsavory (pun intended) characters. In living solely to exact his revenge upon Judge Turpin, Sweeney boldly proclaims "we all deserve to die, Mrs. Lovett, even you Mrs. Lovett, even I." And after witnessing the Judge's crimes that set this revenge drama in motion, we can't help but root for Sweeney to end Turpin's villainy. I suppose if Turpin were Sweeney's only victim, Sweeney might be deemed an anti-hero. But Sweeney's body count is significant and the "purity" of his drive for revenge is tainted by the collateral damage of the innocent lives that are taken as a means to abate his rage as he stalks Turpin.

In Act II, Sweeney jauntily sings to Mrs. Lovett, "It's man devouring man, my dear." In this moment, we come to realize that revenge is no longer his ultimate goal. Sweeney has now developed a taste for the carnage he himself has brought to the pit. In a twisted world, you can dehumanize people, call them "vermin" and justify slaughtering them, no? But then, isn't this the point of the play? Isn't Sweeney Todd a cautionary tale about what happens when we live only for retribution and allow hate to justify our inhumanity? We need to attend this tale of Sweeney Todd to fully absorb and appreciate the impact of its warning. We need to carefully consider how we elect the values that drive us forward and through what lens we choose to see humanity around us.

I commend our students for their courage and strength in embracing the darkness of this play and for confronting its terrible themes with such abandon and passion. This has been a difficult journey; living in this great black pit for weeks on end as the caged birds that bring the only lightness to a dark world. "Darkness cannot drive out darkness; only light can do that. Hate cannot drive out hate; only love can do that." - Martin Luther King Jr. I take great comfort in the light our talented students provide. Embrace this light & enjoy the show.


