

# California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) Pattern

## NOTES

- The Cal-GETC is the singular general education pathway for California Community College (CCC) to fulfill lower-division general education requirements necessary for transfer and admission to the University of California (UC), the California State University (CSU), and some private institutions. It may not be appropriate for some majors, including STEM, or colleges within universities. Consult assist.org and the Moorpark College catalog for Cal-GETC considerations and credit limitations.
- All courses on Cal-GETC must be completed with a minimum grade of "C" or "Pass/Credit". Grades of "C-" are not acceptable.
- A course must be approved to meet the Cal-GETC area requirement during the academic year when it is taken per assist.org. When substituting a course from another California Community College, check assist.org to verify that the course was approved to meet the Cal-GETC area at the college where the course was taken, and in the year it was taken.
- Certain Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams may be used if a minimum score is obtained. CLEP cannot be used for Cal-GETC. See the latest Cal-GETC Standards and/or consult a counselor for the list of allowed exams.
