## California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) Pattern

- The Cal-GETC is the general education (GE) pattern available for California Community College (CCC) to fulfill the lower-division GE requirements necessary for transfer and admission to the University of California (UC), the California State University (CSU), and some private institutions. It may not be appropriate for some majors, including STEM, or colleges within universities. Consult with a counselor and/or the Moorpark College catalog for Cal-GETC considerations and credit limitations.
- A Cal-GETC course must be a minimum of 3 semester units and completed with a grade of "C" or better or a "Pass/Credit". A grade of "C-" is not acceptable.
- A course must be approved to meet the Cal-GETC area requirement during the academic year when it is taken per assist.org. When using a course from another CCC, check assist.org to verify that the course was approved for the GE area at the college where the course was taken, and in the year it was taken.
- IGETC-approved course completed prior to Fall 2025 may be applied in the same area(s) of the Cal-GETC.
- A course can be approved and appears in more than one GE areas. However, it can only be used in ONE GE area.
- Certain Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams may be used if a minimum score is achieved. CLEP and other external exams cannot be used for Cal-GETC. Consult a counselor for catalog for the list of allowed exams.
