AA Degree in General Studies – Patterns 2 and 3 (for students with catalog rights of Fall 2025 or thereafter)

Pattern 2 – is for students who are planning to transfer to a four-year university in high-unit majors or where completion of Cal-GETC is not appropriate or advisable.

Pattern 3 - is designed for students who are planning to transfer to a California four-year university (UC or CSU) and plan to use the Cal-GETC pattern to fulfill their lower-division general education requirements.

NOTE: Transfer requirements vary depending on the major and transfer institution selected. Consult with the intended transfer institution, a Moorpark College counselor, and www.assist.org (for UC/CSU) for admission, general education, and major requirements.

1. Select and complete one of the following General Education Pattern

Pattern 2: Complete courses from the general education pattern of a transfer institution to include, at a minimum, the following VCCCD requirements:

- English Composition (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Oral Communication and Critical Thinking (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Arts and Humanities (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Social and Behavioral Sciences (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Natural Sciences (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Ethnic Studies (3 semester/4 quarter units)
- Health, Wellness, Counseling, and Career Planning (3 units)

Pattern 3: Complete the Cal-GETC Pattern

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2. Choose an Area of Emphasis from one of the four categories listed below.

- Complete a minimum of **18 units in the chosen area of emphasis** with a grade of “C” or better or “P” in each of the courses selected. In addition, of the 18 units, **6 must be within a single discipline.**
