


## RAIDER CENTRAL



## College Lingo 101

Here you can find a list of some of the most common terms you will come across during your time at MC. Remember- if you ever come across something you need more information on, you can always start by reaching out to a **Success Coach!**

**Abbreviated Educational Plan**: A pathway that identifies the courses a new student will take in their first one or two semesters.

**Add Authorization Code:** Four-digit code received from an instructor allowing the student to register in a closed class online using their MyVCCCD student portal.

Comprehensive (Active) Educational Plan: A pathway that identifies the courses a student must take to complete their informed program of study and reach their educational goals. Your Comp Ed Plan will cover ALL of the courses you need to take to achieve your degree. Schedule an appointment with a counselor today!

**CRN**: Course Reference Number is listed in the Schedule of Classes and referenced when students register in courses or make adjustments to their courses. CRNs are unique identifiers for a specific course. For example, ENGL C1000 might have 15 options (referred to as "sections") to choose from- a CRN will help identify which one of the 15 sections you chose.

**Prerequisite**: A requirement which must be completed prior to enrollment in a course and without which a student is highly unlikely to succeed. Prerequisites are listed in the course descriptions in the College Catalog and in the online Schedule of Classes.



## NEW FOR FALL 2025 Cal-GETC

New for ALL students starting Fall 2025 planning to transfer to a UC or a CSU:

Cal-GETC is a new general education pattern **launching Fall 2025**. Cal-GETC is for students planning on transferring to a CSU (California State University) or UC (University of California).

The entire purpose of Cal-GETC is to make things easier on you, the student!

Students who complete the full Cal-GETC GE pattern will have met the lower-division general education requirements for the CSU <u>and</u> UC.

Upon transfer, students who complete the Cal-GETC requirements will <u>only</u> have to complete upper-division general education & major requirements that the university requires.

**Note:** Students planning on applying to a UC campus should check with a counselor to determine if Cal-GETC is recommended for their intended UC major.

If you have any questions about Cal-GETC, your class schedule, or future courses you need to take for your chosen program of study, please reach out to the MC Academic Counseling office.

For students who started at MC prior to Fall 2025, check with your counselor to see if CalGETC is an option for you!
