Dear Dr. Sokenu:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, at its meeting June 4-5, 2025, reviewed the Follow-Up Report and related evidentiary materials submitted by Moorpark College. The Commission also considered the Peer Review Team Follow-Up Report prepared by the follow-up team that visited the institution on April 4, 2025. The purpose of this review was to determine whether the College has addressed the deficiencies identified by the peer review team during the September 25-26, 2023, comprehensive visit and demonstrated compliance with the Standards cited in the Commission's January 16, 2024, Action Letter.

Upon consideration of the information noted above, the Commission acted to **Reaffirm Accreditation** for the remainder of the cycle. The Commission finds that Moorpark College has addressed the compliance requirements, corrected deficiencies, and meets **Standard IV.C.12**.

The Commission requires that you disseminate the Follow-Up Report, the Peer Review Team Report, and this letter to all campus constituencies and the public by placing copies on the College website within seven business days of your receipt. A final copy of the Peer Review Team Report is attached.

The next report from the College will be the Midterm Report¹ due on October 15, 2027. The institution's next comprehensive review will begin with Team ISER Review in the spring term of 2030 and conclude with a Focused Site Visit in the fall term of 2030.
