

CAL-GETC PATHWAY

The California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) is a streamlined general education pathway for California community college students aiming to transfer to either the California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) systems. Effective Fall 2025, Cal-GETC will serve as the primary general education transfer pathway, replacing the previous IGETC and CSU GE-Breadth patterns.
