The Child Development Associate Teacher Certificate program at Moorpark College prepares students for entry-level positions in early childhood education. This program provides foundational knowledge in child development, curriculum planning, and classroom management. Completing the certificate meets the requirements for the California Child Development Associate Teacher Permit, allowing individuals to work in preschools, childcare centers, and other early learning environments. Coursework typically includes child growth and development, teaching strategies, and working with diverse families.
