<b>ANAT M01</b>	<b>Human Anatomy</b>	<b>4 Units</b>
<i>In-Class Hours:</i>	35 lecture, 105 laboratory

Examines the anatomy of human organs and organ systems from a functional perspective that focuses on an understanding of the design of the human body. Teaches, in the laboratory setting, how to distinguish tissue types through histological specimens. Studies the three-dimensional relationship of body structures through required nonhuman mammalian dissection. Demonstrates, using human cadavers, the gross anatomy of the human body.
