The Moorpark College Writing Center wants students to become strong readers and writers. While AI can be used as a learning tool, use of generative AI can be considered academic dishonesty. The Writing Center recommends the following guidelines:

Do

- FOLLOW YOUR PROFESSOR'S AI POLICY
- CITE USE OF AI ASSISTANCE AS A SOURCE
- USE ASSISTANCE **ONLY** AFTER YOUR FIRST DRAFT IS COMPLETE
- BE SPECIFIC AND DIRECT WHEN PROMPTING AI: DON'T LET IT CHANGE YOUR IDEAS
- LISTEN TO YOUR GUT; IF IT FEELS LIKE CHEATING, IT PROBABLY IS

Don't

- LET AI REPLACE YOUR READING AND WRITING SKILLS
- TRUST AI TO FIND RELIABLE SOURCES (DOUBLE-CHECK)
- GENERATE **ANY** TEXT FOR YOUR ASSIGNMENT
- LET AI'S EDITS TAKE OVER YOUR VOICE
- ATTEMPT TO DISGUISE UNETHICAL USE OF AI
