

## AA-T in Elementary Teacher Education

To earn an AA-T in Elementary Teacher Education, students must:

1. Complete 60 semester or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to California State University, including both of the following:
  - A) The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE-Breadth) requirements.
  - B) The coursework required for the AA-T in Elementary Teacher Education as listed in the Moorpark College catalog.
2. Obtain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in all CSU-transferable coursework. While a minimum of 2.0 is required for admission, some transfer institutions and majors may require a higher GPA. Please consult with a counselor for more information.
3. Obtain a grade of “C” or better or “P” in all courses required in the major. Even though a “pass-no-pass” is allowed (Title 5 §55062), it is highly recommended that students complete their major courses with a letter grade (A, B, or C).
4. Complete requirements in residency. For students in the Ventura County Community College District, a minimum of 12 semester units must be completed in residence within the college district.

Students transferring to a CSU campus that accepts the AA-T in Elementary Teacher Education will be required to complete no more than 60 units after transfer to earn a bachelor's degree (unless the major is a designated “high-unit” major at a particular campus). This degree may not be the best option for students intending to transfer to a particular CSU campus or to a university or college that is not part of the CSU system. Students should consult with a counselor to obtain more information on university admission and transfer requirements.

### NOTES:

1. Although the IGETC pattern is permissible for the Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT), **MATH M10 Mathematics for Elementary Teachers** is **not** an approved course for the IGETC pattern, therefore it's recommended that the student complete the CSU GE-Breadth pattern for this degree or complete a transferable math course that is approved for the IGETC, as part of the completion of the IGETC.
2. Students transferring to **California State University, Northridge (CSUN)** as a Liberal Studies major must complete GEOL M121 for Earth Science and PHSC M01 and PHSC M01L for the Physical Science requirements.
3. Students transferring to **California State University, Channel Islands (CSUCI)** should take the following courses from LIST B and C: DANC M24 and MUS M24, CD/EDU M08, EDU M10, ENGL M40, and HIST M143. CSUCI has an approved subject matter program and the inclusion of the prescribed courses above allows students who

graduate from the program to be waived from taking the Multiple Subject exam required for graduates of non-waiver programs. In addition, CSUCI offers an Integrated Multiple Subject or Educational Specialist program that includes the teacher credentialing program for interested students. This program allows for the completion of both the Bachelor's Degree and teaching credential simultaneously. Students interested in the integrated program must apply and possess a 3.0 or better GPA.
