The Cal-GETC may be used to meet the lower-division general education requirements for the University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU), or to obtain an associate degree at Moorpark College. The Cal-GETC is not recommended for all majors and may not be appropriate for STEM majors. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester or 4 quarter units and must be completed with a grade of "C" or better, Pass/Credit, or a minimum score on an acceptable AP/IB exam. A grade of "C-" or Pass/Credit is not acceptable if below 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Coursework from California Community Colleges (CCC) must be approved for the GE area at the time the course was completed, as noted on assist.org. Non-CCC coursework may be applied if it meets the Cal-GETC standards and criteria. A course may be approved and appear in more than one area; however, it can only be used in one area. **NOTE:** courses that meet Areas 1B and 6 are normally not offered at institutions outside of the CCC system. **Full Cal-GETC** certification requires the completion of ALL Areas (1-6). **Partial Certification** is possible if no more than two courses are missing. The missing course(s) cannot be from Area 1 or 2. Refer to assist.org, transfer campus website, and/or consult a counselor for appropriate course placement, credit limitations, and other important information.
