Compared to Spring 2025**




# OUTSTANDING TRANSFER OUTCOMES


- CSU system acceptance rate of 89% with 1158 students accepted.





**83% of former MC CTE students** who are employed full-time are working in a job closely related to their field of study

**Ranked #7 statewide for ROI** by the College Futures Foundation  
MC students increased their salaries by 37% within a year after leaving MC.

**In 2025, over 300 local employers** are engaged in partnership with the college.

**227 student internships** completed in 2024-2025

**Spotlight on Nursing:** nearly 100% five-year average licensure exam pass rate, 100% job placement rate, and 100% employer satisfaction rate.


