NOTES

1. IGETC may be used to meet the lower division general education for the CSU and/or UC. IGETC is not recommended for all majors and may not be appropriate for majors in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM) area. For more information on IGETC for STEM see a counselor.
2. **Full IGETC Certification** requires the completion of ALL Areas (including Area 6 LOTE). **Partial IGETC Certification** – missing a maximum of two courses. Partial certification that does not include completion of Areas 1 and/or 2 may make a student ineligible for meeting the minimum admission transfer requirements for CSU and/or UC.
3. Students obtaining an ADT using the IGETC without the completion of the Oral Communication (Area 1C) will not meet the CSU admissions requirements.
4. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester or 4 quarter units and must be completed with a "C" or better, or Pass/Credit. A grade of "C-" is not acceptable. The UC system allows a maximum of 14 semester units graded "Pass/No-Pass".
